As parents you entrust us with your children's education every day. This is the overall results of the annual questionnaire as part of the school's cycle of self-evaluation. Thank you to everyone who participated. We collected information on many different areas. Your views are valued on things you think the school does well as well as areas where you would like to see improvement. The results of it have fed into the 2019 -20 improvement plan.

We have written our vision 'Empowering our children to flourish and achieve under God's love'. This is underpinned by the idea we want all to 'Live life in all it's fullness' John 10:10. We use our Rainbow Promise and Owl learning to help us achieve this. Every child should be able to progress to reach their potential during their time at Jennett's Park

There were over 70 parent responses both paper and via online questionnaire. Each class was also asked about the same areas. Year 6 Leavers completed an anonymous questionnaire. There were 420 children responses. After each result we have indicated whether this is a Children's opinion (C) or Parental (P) opinion

You have on the last page a Year on Year comparison data for last year and this. Thank you for your support it is very heart-warming to hear. If you wish to have a meeting with me regarding any personal issues please make an appointment via the office.

We divided the questions into ones relating to

Areas you thought we should improve on

Whilst we have improved in most areas in both children and parents perceptions there are still some areas to focus on:

1) Leadership and Management of the School

Communication around trips to be clearer (P) *You have commented that general communication is much improved.*

2) The Behaviour and Safety of Pupils at the School

That the behaviour policy is clear to all (P) *The policy is clear but you felt some individuals needed to understand what that meant for their children.*

That bullying is dealt with effectively – whilst 48% improvement is something to celebrate we want no instances.

Responding to concerns raised (P) *Whilst there is an improvement we want all concerns heard.*

More outdoor work (C) *You were aware as parents of improvements but children would like more.*

Reduced amount of information on dates on website to reduce complexity of looking in two places.

Future plans

Meet the Teacher sessions Y1-Y6 planned and with a specific focus on end of year expectations, homework and Reading.

Plans to communicate trips and costings at outset of year so people can plan and budget for these costs

Make clear how we use Squid, the website and Marvellous me to communicate to both staff and parents.

Try to avoid where possible to events on one day.
