Probably best to read the questions and plan your route. Remember they could be on Jennett's Park or Wykery Copse.

You now have a choice. You can either make this the end of your treasure hunt, or, if you are feeling a little more adventurous, you can email us at events@jpca.org.uk telling us the name of the author, name of child entering and year group. If you are correct, we will email you a set of questions about the author. Complete these questions and send back to us and we will ensure you receive a certificate of completion. 1. A famous wizard lives at number 2.
2. Batman's side kick can be found at number 26
3. A dark coloured hat can be found at number 2.
4. House number 5 always hangs this type of decoration in the lane.
5. Groups of people gather here for meetings and parties.
6. A famous bird that is often hunted in the fields lives at number 3.
7. A boy whose name begins with "L" lives at number 2
8. This road runs between a "Butler" and a "Copse" – go to number 1
9. A precious metal rides the waves at number 7
